1 Eligibility

Parents of children who are Singapore Citizens or Singapore Permanent Residents (SPR) are eligible for this programme. However, if there is an overwhelming response, priority will be given to parents whose child is a Singapore Citizen. In addition, selection interviews may be conducted.

Parents are to note that this scheme accords an eligibility to register in Yangzheng Primary school under Phase 2B of the Primary One Registration Exercise; it does not guarantee their children of a place. - B. Photocopy of birth certificate of child born between 2 Jan 2012 and 1 Jan 2013

4 Application Closing Date

- A. Period of Application is from 2 February (8am) to 28 February (5pm) 2017. Success of application is not on a first-come-first-served basis.
- B. Completed Application Forms must be received by the School no later than **28 February (5pm) 2017**. The School regrets that all Application Forms received after 28 February 2017 will not be considered or processed and appeals will not be entertained.
- C. The School will not be returning any Application Forms received (including Application Forms which are not properly completed, or which are received after 28 February 2017) to Applicants.

5 Application Timeline

March	Shortlisted applicants may be notified to attend face-to-face meetings/interviews if any, which may be conducted in groups.
March/April	Meetings/interviews with shortlisted applicants if any.
March/April	School will notify all applicants the outcome of their application.

6 Results of Applications

Applicants who have not been shortlisted for interview will also be notified in writing by mid-April. The school will not be able to advise applicant on the status of application through telephone enquiries. We seek applicant's understanding and cooperation on this.

Successful applicants will have to serve and complete 40 hours of voluntary service within the stipulated time if they wish to be eligible for Phase 2B of the Primary One registration exercise.
